

CECAD Travel Grants available

CECAD offers up to seven travel grants (1,500 EUR each) to CECAD Postdocs and last year PhD students. The purpose of these travel fellowships is to enhance opportunities to actively advance your Postdoc career perspectives through networking with prospective host PIs while visiting a conference.

Presentation of your scientific achievements as first author in a poster or talk is a prerequisite to be considered for funding.

CECAD members interested in applying for funding should send an application including the following details:

- Short description of your motivation to attend the conference outlining how participation in this particular conference would advance your academic career
- Short outline of your strategy to actively pursue career opportunities during this meeting (this should include the names of 1-2 attending PIs who you intend to meet and why)
- Short description explaining in which way you are going to present your work during the conference (poster, talk, etc.)
- Brief CV (max. 1 page)
- Abstract for the conference
- Program of the conference

Deadline for application is September 15, 2019. The conference should take place between January 1 and December 31, 2019. Conferences that took place between January 1 and September 14, 2019 can, when approved for funding by CECAD, be subsequently refunded. Preference will be given for applications coming from different labs.
